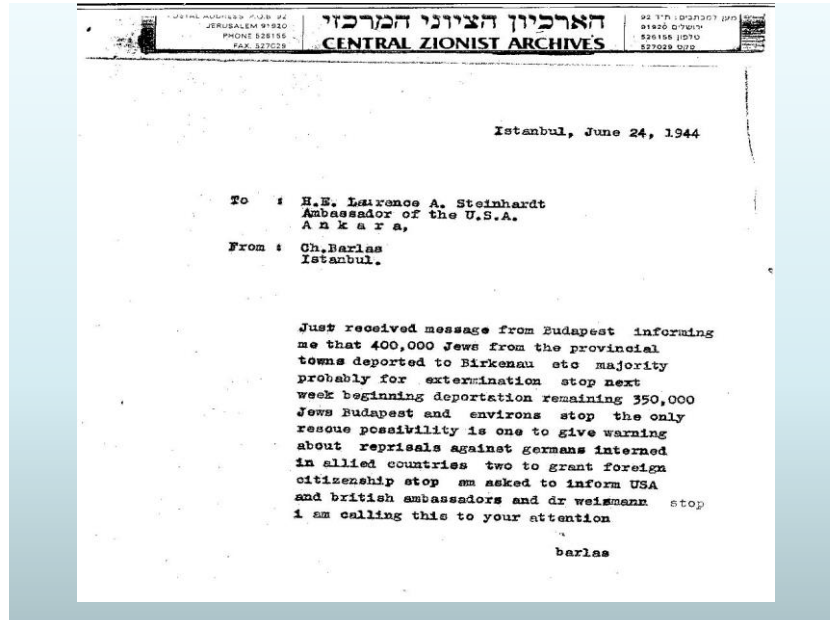

W: Refugees.	<b>Deportation of Jews from Hungary to Birkenau.</b> Transmits message received from Krausz, Jewish Agency representative in Budapest stating that about 400,000 Jews have been deported to Birkenau, probably for extermination. The citizens are averse to the deportation of the remaining 350,000 Jews, and adds that the only rescue possibilities are to give warning about reprisals against Germans interned in Allied countries or to grant foreign citizenship to Hungarian Jews. Requests that the British and United States Ambassadors be informed, as well as Dr. Weizmann.
